

Mission Trip Packing List

Basics

- Bible, notebook, pen
- Flexible, servant-like attitude
- Sleeping bag/linens
- Pillow
- Alarm Clock
- Camera and charger etc.
- Prescription meds (in original containers with Dr. info)
- Over the counter meds usually taken

Clothing²

- Work clothes for 2 days (will get dirty)
- Casual “school” clothes (jeans, etc. for school and church groups)
- Underwear, socks
- Work shoes or boots (will get muddy)
- Casual shoes for school/church
- Coat, gloves, hat
- Jacket, sweatshirt, sweater (lighter layers work best)³
- Modest sleeping clothes
- Rain gear
- Flip flops, etc. in dorm and bathroom

Toiletries

- Towel
- Washcloth
- Soap
- Shampoo/Conditioner
- Deodorant
- Hand sanitizer
- Toothbrush/toothpaste
- Contacts, glasses etc.
- Hair brush, comb, dryer, etc.

Optional

- Earplugs for quiet sleeping
- Devices and chargers (WIFI is available on campus)⁴
- PG or G DVDs for the bus

- Scripts, cue cards
- Costume items
